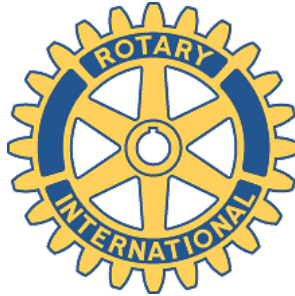

All applicants will be considered without regard to race, sex, national origin, religion, age, or disability. Only seniors may apply.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CRITERIA

1. To apply for a Salado Education Foundation (SEF) scholarship, students must have a GPA minimum of 2.75 or equivalent for higher education scholarships and 2.0 or equivalent for career and technology scholarships.
2. All applicants will be considered equally.
3. Early graduates may apply for a scholarship.
4. Applicants must have been in the district for a minimum of two academic years.
5. During your studies at the higher education institution of your choice, recipients of SEF scholarships must maintain a 2.75 grade point average (GPA) for the year. The GPA must be a minimum of 24 semester hours during the 12 month period. Failure to maintain a 2.75 GPA during the year causes suspension of the scholarship. The scholarship will not be reinstated until the recipient shows proof of maintaining a 2.75 GPA for a full year for 24 semester hours. Failure to maintain the required 2.75 GPA for two years causes automatic forfeiture of the scholarship with no cause for reinstatement.
6. The scholarship year starts in the fall semester following awarding of the scholarship to the recipient. The funds will be paid annually for the fall semester. Salado Education Foundation scholarship funds are paid out at \$500 per year for the \$1,000 and \$2,000 scholarships. Other scholarships the SEF administers for individuals and organizations are paid in one lump sum.
7. The scholarship terminates at the end of five years (for the four year scholarship) from the start date for the academic scholarship and three years (for the two year scholarship) from the start date for the technical scholarship. The time period can only be extended for extenuating circumstances by a vote of the SEF Board of Directors.
8. (A) The recipient must present proof of college enrollment to: Salado Education Foundation Treasurer, P.O. Box 458, Salado, TX 76571, for the initial scholarship to be paid. All scholarships will be paid directly to the education institution.
(B) The student must furnish to the Treasurer the address of where the scholarship funds are to be sent.
(C) The recipient must furnish to the Treasurer a certified copy of the college transcript each year thereafter for subsequent scholarships to be paid. (Students should provide fall and spring semester transcripts during the summer in order to receive a fall annual payment.)
9. If single year scholarships are awarded, students must furnish the requirements of paragraph 8(A) and 8(B), above, to the Treasurer for the scholarship to be paid.
10. Three (3) letters of recommendation (only one recommendation will be allowed from SHS teachers or administrators).
11. In addition to the scholarships awarded according to the above criteria, the Salado Education Foundation will also award the following scholarships according to the criteria designated by the donors:

2018 SALADO ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CRITERIA

1. Salado Rotary Club will award a total of \$500 in scholarships this year. These may be applied to all post-secondary education including 4-year, 2-year, and trade schools.
2. Only seniors may apply.
3. All information considered for this scholarship must be contained in this application. The only attachments permitted are the required essay and letters of recommendation. No resumes or other documents will be considered.
4. Applicant must enclose a copy of certified high school transcript.
5. Applicant must provide two (2) letters of recommendation; one from an individual in the community and one from school personnel who know applicant's character and needs.
6. Rotary is an international service organization with an emphasis on service to others. Special attention will be paid to Part III of the application.
7. The stated deadline is final. No late applications will be accepted.

2018 SALADO LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CRITERIA

The Salado Lions Club will award a total of two \$1500 scholarships this year.

1. Only SISD Seniors may apply.
2. Completed application is due by noon on 4/27/2018. Applications after this time and date will not be accepted.
3. Two letters of reference must be provided. One from an individual in the community and one from a teacher from your high school.
4. *Please write an additional essay on your community service in Salado over the last four years.
